

Two-week Training Programme for Refugee Women:

Become an educator, child caregiver or housekeeper.

CareForward is a free two-week training programme designed to help refugee women in Berlin into careers within the care and education sectors through providing information, assistance and advice.

Our free two-week training programme includes:

- Professional insight: Education and care professionals explain their everyday work.
- Career guidance: Find out about the skills and professional training required.
- Individual support: Advice on your career choices, searching for jobs and creating applications.
- A participation certificate, free childcare and an interpreter.

All participants must:

- Possess a valid German residence and work permit
- Reside in Berlin
- Be able and interested in working within the care and education sectors
- German & English skills are not required but beneficial (an interpreter is available)

CareForward will take place in Berlin in October 2017 (precise date to be confirmed) and is free of charge. Additionally, free childcare will be provided for the duration of the training session.
